



Blaster Restrictions

If bringing your own blaster(s), it must:

- Fire only approved foam projectiles
 - Full-length, half-length, Nseries, Mega, & Mega XL darts;
 - Vortex discs;
 - Rival foam ball ammo; and/or
 - Foam rockets
- Be made available for inspection, if requested
- Be tested on-site and verified to shoot within the Feet Per Second event cap (the cap of this event is 130 FPS).
- Not use any form of combustion or compressed gas for propulsion
- Not have any protruding sharp objects





Shield Requirements

- Players may use any number of Shields.
- Hitting players with shields is prohibited.
- Any homemade shield of any size qualifies as a Large Shield.
- Shield edges must have at least 3/8 inches of foam padding around the perimeter.
- Shields must be free of sharp points and edges.
- If using a Large Shield, a player is restricted to using a Shield-Legal Blaster
 - Shield-Legal blasters are any physical size, 12 shots or less capacity, with no removable dart magazines. It can fire any size foam projectile approved for the Event.
- Any Hasbro company product, branded Nerf, with the intended use of being a shield, is a Small Shield.
 - Includes shields that are intended to be mounted on blasters.
- Players may use any blaster when using a Small Shield.
